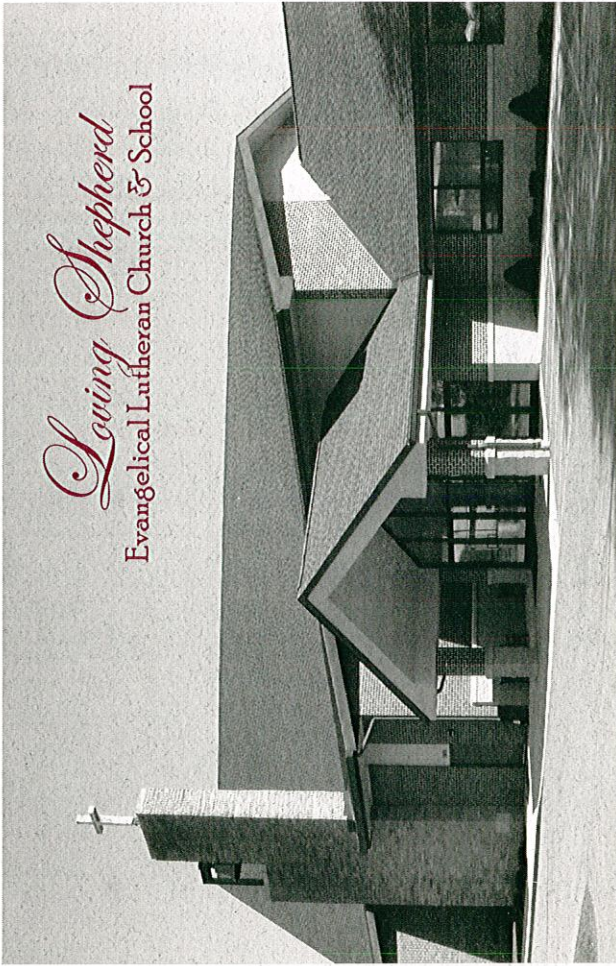
There is also a complete program of interscholastic athletic activities. Please call the school for more information.

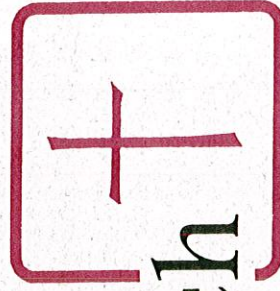

A TRUTH PRESERVING CHURCH

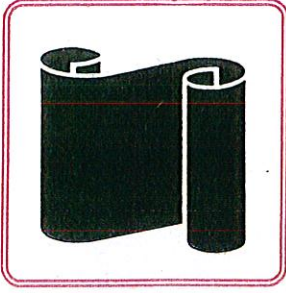
